Below is the standard reply to all questions regarding solar installs.

Good afternoon,

To do both residential and commercial installation of solar arrays in SC you will need the minimum of a electrical contractors license. If the installation is roof mounted, then an additional roofing license will be required to make penetrations of roof membranes and if the systems require additional structural framing members due to increased wind and seismic loading, then a structural framing classification will be required also. If the systems are all ground mounted, then electrical contractor and structural shapes licenses are the minimum required. Also each jurisdiction may require a separate business license to conduct business in their community. \*The SS License (Structural Shapes) is for a ground mounted system or a roof mounted system that involves no structural issues or roof penetrations.
